Every rescued animal has a different story and circumstances as well as temperament and personality. Rocky Mountain Animal Rescue (R-mar) takes hundreds of dogs and cats to vets each year for spay/neuter, vaccinations, de-worming, emergency medical, etc. In some circumstances the adopter will take the pet to the veterinarian for the above listed and/or for completion of shots, etc.

SPAY/NEUTER: If a pet has not yet been spayed or neutered due to its age, is pregnant, or other reason, adopter agrees to a \$100 deposit and will have the pet spayed/ neutered within the time frame or circumstances noted here: Rocky Mountain Animal Rescue Adoption Agreement - Page 2



TRAINING: Adopter agrees to educate their pet by using humane methods, implement rules and boundaries, maintain fair leadership, and contact an experienced professional for advise if needed.

CARE & EXERCISE: This includes proper crate training (if needed) but not excessive use of it, exercise including dog parks, play dates, day care, walk and hikes or whatever best suits your pet and lifestyle. Ongoing exercise and socialization is critical.

BRINGING YOUR NEW PET HOME: Walk on leash around the perimeter of your home and neighbourhood so your dog can smell and learn its surroundings as well as to begin to establish yourself as pack leader. Take out to DESIGNATED potty area when dog is finished eating, sleeping or playing. Due to continual danger of getting lost, ran over by vehicles, attacked by instinctual prey drive by some dogs, etc., cats need to remain indoors. Keep litter box clean daily.

RETURN POLICY: R-mar accepts pets back, however, may not be available immediately upon adopters request due to lack of space, no available fosterers or other circumstances. R-mar will refund the cost of a pet within two weeks of adoption minus \$150 for time involved with emails, phone calls, counselling, adoption and return process. If pet cost the total of \$150 there is no refund.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Adopter understands and agrees there are no guarantees regarding the health or temperament of dog or cat and agree to assume all risk of loss, injury, and damage to other people, pets or property. Adopters agree to be solely responsible for the pet(s) and to indemnify and hold harmless Rocky Mountain Animal Rescue, Rory O'Neill, and all volunteers associated with the rescue organization from claims of liability for the conduct of this animal on or after the date of this contract. This Release of Liability and indemnification shall apply to all known and unknown damages or costs resulting from the adoption, ownership or control of such animal(s).
